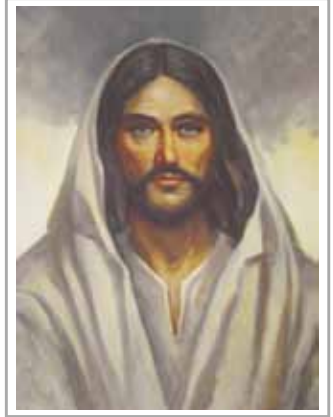

DEPARTING FROM HONOLULU, HAWAII (Saturday, June 19, 2010)

EMBARKATION: 11:30 A.M.–5:00 P.M. DEPART: 7:00 P.M.

MAUI (June 20, 8:00 A.M.–June 21, 6:00 P.M.): On the island of Maui, mornings of birdsong swell into days of pure exhilaration. From staggering natural beauty to one-of-a-kind adventures, Maui is a magical, tropical playground like no other. Maui is home to a unique spirit. You will recognize it in the natural smiles that greet you daily, and you will feel its presence long after you depart.

HILO (June 22, 8:00 A.M.–6:00 P.M.): The Big Island's most tropical town is nestled between Mauna Kea and Mauna Loa. Until recently, windward Hawaii's major city, Hilo, was the economic and political powerhouse of the island. It's still the capital, and home to 45,000 people, but as the sugar mills close and the significance of Kona-side tourism increases, it now feels more like a rather traditional small town. As a place to visit, it's relaxed and attractive, spread over a surprisingly large area but with an appealingly old-fashioned downtown district where you can stroll between friendly cafés, street markets and historic sites.

KONA (June 23, 7:00 A.M.–6:00 P.M.): Join a wonderful journey of discovery through the historic city of Kona and along Hawaii's beautiful sun-drenched Gold Coast. A stop at the Kona coffee house gives you a chance to sip the flavorful brew while browsing through the shop and exhibits. Enjoy the breathtaking sea views of Kealahou Bay and visit St. Benedict's historic painted church. Then, get ready to discover old Hawaii at Pu'uuhouua O Honaunau National Historical Park.

KAUAI (June 24, 8:00 A.M.–June 25, 2:00 P.M.): Kauai basks amidst the sparkling blue waters of the Pacific Ocean, about 20 minutes by air from Honolulu. Formed some six million years ago, the island encompasses roughly 550 square miles and is the oldest and northernmost of the main Hawaiian Islands. Come, discover the legendary aloha spirit that abounds in this friendly garden island paradise.

Terms and Conditions

The invoice/statement you will receive confirming your reservation is an agreement between Inspiration Cruises & Tours, Inc. (ICT) and the passenger. Travel dates include sailing days only; air travel and forced overnight hotels are additional. All prices, payments, penalties, and change fees are quoted per passenger based on double occupancy (two persons per room). Sites, artists, speakers, and/or schedules are subject to change. Carefully review the Terms and Conditions found on the back of your invoice/statement and all documentation you receive in connection with your travel. Stanley Gordon 'Portrait of Jesus' is valued at \$2,500. One portrait per cabin.

PRICES—All prices quoted are in U.S. dollars and are based on the current rate of international exchange between the U.S. dollar and foreign currencies at time of publication. Whenever possible, ICT obtains price guarantees from suppliers. However, depending upon the strength of the U.S. dollar and the fluctuating nature of fuel and other taxes, published prices are subject to change without notice and will be chargeable to the passenger up to the time of departure.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICES—Passport costs; transit to/from pier, travel to/from the departure city; pre/post hotels; items of a personal nature including, but not limited to, laundry, room service at hotels, meals in transit, phone calls, etc.

TRAVEL INSURANCE—Brochures for independent travel insurance, which can include medical coverage, travel delay protection, trip cancellation and interruption, as well as some instances of forced single occupancy due to roommate cancellation will be sent to you with your confirmation packet. Premiums vary based upon coverage selected. PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP—There is no need for a passport when you sail on any Hawaii inter-island cruise. All that is required is a government-issued photo I.D. which includes a passport or a valid driver's license with a photo. **Travelers originating from outside the U.S.** will need a valid passport, and should consult their country's embassy regarding specific requirements for entry into each and every country of destination. Your passport name must match the name on your cruise reservation and airline/cruiseline ticket or you may be denied boarding.
